• God's call is effective. It is irresistible grace.

F. God PROMISES to bring me to glory.

To this he called you through our gospel, <u>so that you may obtain the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ</u>. 2 Thessalonians 2:14 (ESV)

Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword?... For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 8:35, 38–39 (ESV)

4. Command — Hold on to the truth!

So then, brothers, stand firm and hold to the traditions that you were taught by us, either by our spoken word or by our letter. 2 Thessalonians 2:15 (ESV)

...maintain the traditions even as I delivered them to you. 1 Corinthians 11:2 (ESV)

O Timothy, guard the deposit entrusted to you... 1 Timothy 6:20 (ESV)

5. Closing — Pray for God's comfort when we feel insecure.

Now may our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God our Father, who loved us and gave us eternal comfort and good hope through grace, comfort your hearts and establish them in every good work and word. 2 Thessalonians 2:16–17 (ESV)

1. Background On The Antichrist

...as you have heard that antichrist is coming, so now many antichrists have come... 1 John 2:18 (ESV)

For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work... 2 Thessalonians 2:7 (ESV)

...the mystery of lawlessness is already at work. Only he who now restrains it will do so until he is out of the way. And then the lawless one will be revealed,... 2 Thessalonians 2:7–8 (ESV)

The coming of the lawless one is by the activity of Satan with all power and false signs and wonders, and with all wicked deception for those who are perishing, because they refused to love the truth and so be saved.

2 Thessalonians 2:9–10 (ESV)

For false christs and false prophets will arise and perform great signs and wonders, so as to lead astray, if possible, even the elect. Matthew 24:24 (ESV)

You are of your father the devil,... does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks out of his own character, <u>for he is a liar and</u> the father of lies. John 8:44 (ESV)

And no wonder, for even <u>Satan disguises himself as an angel of light. So it is no surprise if his servants, also, disguise themselves as servants of righteousness...</u> 2 Corinthians 11:14–15 (ESV)

...many deceivers have gone out into the world, those who do not confess the coming of Jesus Christ in the flesh. Such a one is the deceiver and the antichrist. 2 John 7 (ESV)

For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, 1 Timothy 2:5 (ESV)

- Jehovah's Witnesses Jesus is not God. He is the first created being of God.
- Mormons Jesus is the child of God the Father and an earthly mother. He was created and did not always exist. Jesus and Satan are brothers.
- Muslims Jesus is a prophet, like Mohammed.

No, <u>I imply that what pagans sacrifice they offer to demons and not to God. I do not want you to be participants with demons.</u> 1 Corinthians 10:20 (ESV)

And they worshiped the dragon, for he had given his authority to the beast, and they worshiped the beast, saying, "Who is like the beast, and who can fight against it?" Revelation 13:4 (ESV)

Also <u>it was allowed to make war on the saints and to conquer them. And authority was given it over every tribe and people and language and nation,...</u>
Revelation 13:7 (ESV)

...and all who dwell on earth will worship it, <u>everyone whose name has not been</u> written before the foundation of the world in the book of life of the Lamb who was <u>slain</u>. Revelation 13:8 (ESV)

...he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will, to the praise of his glorious grace,... Ephesians 1:4–6 (ESV)

C. God chose me.

But we ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers beloved by the Lord, because God chose you as the firstfruits to be saved,... 2 Thessalonians 2:13 (ESV)

...God has chosen you <u>from the beginning</u> for salvation... 2 Thessalonians 2:13 (NASB 95)

...And the dwellers on earth whose names have not been written in the book of life from the foundation of the world will marvel to see the beast,...

Revelation 17:8 (ESV)

Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. Romans 8:33 (ESV)

You did not choose me, but I chose you... John 15:16 (ESV)

- This crushes pride.
- This gives joy.
- This brings security.

... I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ. Philippians 1:6 (ESV)

D. God transforms me.

• God enables me to believe the truth.
