

Part 2 - Sermon Review

2. Read Daniel 5:1-4. Why did Belshazzar use the cups from the temple in Jerusalem?
3. Read Galatians 6:7. What is the danger of deliberate sin against God?
4. What was God's motive for crashing the party with the fingers of a hand inscribing on the palace wall a warning of immanent destruction only hours before it happened?
5. God used Babylon as the instrument of discipline for his people's sin. Read Jeremiah 50:13-14. If Babylon was doing God's will when they destroyed Jerusalem, why did God destroy them for doing it? What does this teach us about God's wrath against those he uses to discipline us today?
6. The prophet Jeremiah prophesied about Babylon's destruction before it happened. What specific details of the destruction were given by God? What does this tell us about God's control of our future?
