Getting to Know Each Other

1. How have you seen God at work in the past week? How was that an encouragement to you?

Part 2 - Application

2. This Sunday, Pastor Kurt talked about "glory." How would you define glory? What makes something glorious?
3. **Read Ephesians 4:1.** How does who we are affect how we live? In other words, how does our identity as children of God affect how we live from moment to moment?
 - a. Have you ever fallen short of the calling God has on your life? How did you overcome this failure and learn from it?
 - b. A friend of yours is asking you how they can glorify God at their job. How would you help them work through this question?

4. **Read Ephesians 4:2.** How does a spirit of humility, gentleness, and patience glorify God? Which of these three areas is a strength of yours? Which is an area of weakness? As a group, think of ways you can cultivate these three attributes this week.
 - a. Humility. (*Read Philippians 2:1-10*)
 - b. Gentleness. (*Read Titus 3:1-8*)
 - c. Patience. (*Read Jas. 5:7-11*)
5. **Read Ephesians 4:3-6.** How does Christian unity glorify God?

Part 3 - Digging Deeper

Praying for Others

In Paul's letter to the Colossians, he tells the church the purpose he has been praying for them:

"so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God." (Col. 1:10 ESV)
