By faith Abraham, even though he was past age—and Sarah herself was barren—was enabled to become a father because <u>he considered him faithful who had made the promise</u>. And so from this one man, and <u>he as good as dead</u>, came descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky and as countless as the sand on the seashore. Hebrews 11:11-12

Noah - Faith is obeying God.

By faith Noah, being warned by God <u>concerning events as</u> <u>yet unseen</u>, in <u>reverent fear constructed an ark</u> for the saving of his household. By this he condemned the world and became an heir of the righteousness that comes by faith. Hebrews 11:7

"I hate divorce." Malachi 2:16

They said to him, "Why then did Moses command one to give a certificate of divorce and to send her away?"
